#### Transport

Dunboyne/Clonee is situated on one of the principal arterial motorway to the capital, M3. This motorway connects directly Dunboyne/Clonee to the M50 (Dublin Orbital Motorway) with Dublin airport and Dublin port.

Public transport is provided by the state bus company with scheduled services from Dunboyne/Clonee to Dublin and other locations. In addition, area is served by two railway stations. Dunboyne station offers service into Dublin Pearse which connects to the DART (Dublin Area Rapid System) and other rail services.

Connolly Hospital is located 6 miles/16 minutes from the area.
