



Business & Industry

Navan has seven key business enterprise zones all of which benefit from a widely dispersed fibre optic ring delivering high speed broadband. The premier business location in Navan is the **IDA Business and Technology Park**, a 91 acre landscaped development, built and maintained to exacting standards. The park also offers greenfield sites to suit both manufacturing and international services industries. It is ideally located close to junction 8 on the M3 motorway.

Transport

Navan is situated on the M3, one of the principal arterial Motorways to Dublin. This links to the M50, the Dublin Orbital Motorway which provides the central hub to the national notorway network.

In addition, Navan is linked through the national primary route, N51 eastbound to the M2 to Derry and M1 to Belfast and westbound to the M6 to Galway.

Time & Distance from Navan to Airport and Sea Ports

36 mins - 28 miles to the M50 motorway 42 mins - 35 miles by the M3, M50, M1 motorways to Dublin Airport 45 mins - 34 miles by the M3, M50, M1 motorways to Dublin Port 27 mins - 17 miles by the N51 national primary route to Drogheda Port

Public transport is provided by the state bus company with 9 scheduled services from Navan to Dublin and other locations.

Hotels

Physiotherapists - 6 Practices


The Doctor on Call Service is provided from the local hospital.
