Overview

Navan Business & Technology Park was established in the late 1990's by The IDA (Industrial Development Agency) and has been landscaped to a very high standard. It comprises a 91 acres (37 hectare) site with premier quality commercial properties from purpose built contemporary business facilities that are ready for occupation.

In addition there are green field sites, fully zoned and serviced that offer 'quick start' opportunities to create a new customized facility. The variable plots can provide units, designed with flexibility in mind, with room for 100% expansion, reflecting the ever changing requirement of international manufacturing industries.

The Park is situated in an area zoned Objective E2 under the Navan Development Plan 2009 - 2015. This zoning allows for "light industrial and industrial type office development in a high quality campus environment".

Navan Business & Technology Park and the adjoining Johnstown Business Park contain a cluster of Financial Services companies together with key Public Services operations including providers of 24 hour emergency call services.

This concurrence of similar kinds of businesses within this area shows the depth of the skills, knowledge and experience of staff available locally which can support new start-up operations here.

Transport Infrastructure

Provision of an effective transport infrastructure is a major competitive determinant for locating a business. Navan Business & Technology Park is perfectly situated on the M3, one of the principal arterial motorways in Ireland. This provides an effortless link to the M50, which is the central hub to the national motorway network.

Navan's transport network allows fast and easy access to Dublin, Belfast, and to the rest of the country. The Business Park is also connected through the national primary route, N51 eastbound to the M2 (Derry), the M1 (Belfast) and westbound to the M6 (Galway).

Strong Labour Market

The population of Navan is young and growing, making it the 5th largest town in Ireland. The Business Park in Navan has the proximity to a large and diverse labour force with appropriate skills sets for any incoming business.

Overall the population of Navan and its environs has increased by a phenomenal 94% between 1996 and 2006. In addition, the region has the youngest population profile of any part of Ireland.

Education & Training Proximity

A well educated workforce is a crucial consideration for any business looking to locate in an area. This region has a highly rated education system with proximity to six of Ireland's leading third level universities and technological institutes. These are located within 45 minutes of Navan with easy access to focused training programmes and courses.

Complementing this provision are a number of agencies including FAS (Training & Employment Authority) and Meath VEC (Vocational Education Committee) which provide a wide range of training courses locally. The talent pipeline is enhanced by increased number of Maths, Science and Technology graduates, with a 37% rise since 2000.

Local Language Capabilities

Language skills are the key element for a global company operating on a trans-national basis. The region has a wide range of nationalities living locally with more than 30 languages spoken as mother tongues. This factor can support a global business operating from the Business Park in Navan.


