The Cathaoirleach proposed a suspension of Standing Orders, which was seconded by **Councillor Ronan McKenna** to pay tribute to the late **Councillor Joe Reilly** who died on the 1st June. Before taking contributions, the Cathaoirleach issued a statement in relation to Councillor Wayne Forde, informing the meeting that Councillor Forde had been advised that due to ill health and worsening medical conditions and problems, he has requested some 'Leave of Absence' from attending statutory meetings and bodies for the foreseeable future. It was confirmed that Cllr. Forde will continue his normal day to day work as a Councillor.

This was noted by the Councillors.

Tributes to the late Councillor Reilly continued with many contributions made by Councillors, and sincere sympathy was extended to the Reilly family. It was acknowledged that the late Councillor Reilly had served the people of Navan, and beyond, with great dedication. It was noted that he always strived to give people a voice and make Navan a better place. Councillors acknowledged his loyalty, knowledge, sense of humour and his ability to build relationships. The Chief Executive also paid tribute to the late Councillor Reilly and acknowledged the huge loss to his family, the Sinn Féin party and to the people of Navan. She also paid tribute to his strategic approach as a Councillor and noted the respectful and courteous way that he interacted with staff.





A five minute recess was then taken as a mark of respect to the late Councillor Reilly.

1.0 Election of Cathaoirleach

The Cathaoirleach, **Councillor Gerry O' Connor**, reflected on his year as Cathaoirleach. He thanked Leas Chathaoirleach, Councillor Francis Deane, for the support during the year and also acknowledged the cooperation of his fellow Councillors in the conduct of Council meetings. He made reference to the many opportunities and challenges that the role presented, and noted that he attended 200 functions across the county. He thanked the Chief Executive, and all the officials for their assistance and generosity throughout the year. The Councillors and the Chief Executive acknowledged the commitment of Councillor O' Connor both to the role of Cathaoirleach and to the economic development of the county.

The Cathaoirleach then invited nominations for the position of Cathaoirleach.

Councillor Tom Kelly was proposed for the position of Cathaoirleach by **Councillor Brian Fitzgerald** and seconded by **Councillor Paddy Meade**.

Councillor Ronan McKenna noted that the Fianna Fáil group would not be proposing their candidate (Councillor Wayne Harding) for Cathaoirleach, as a mark of respect to the Harding family on their recent bereavement. He also informed that the Fianna Fáil group would be abstaining from the roll call vote.

Councillor Sinéad Burke was proposed for the position of Cathaoirleach by **Councillor Maria**O' Kane and seconded by **Councillor Eimear Ferguson**.
