1.	Minutes of Previous Meeting
	The minutes of the previous meeting held on 17 November, 2015 were adopted on the proposition of Councillor Tommy Reilly seconded by Councillor Darren O'Rourke.
2.	Matters arising from the Minutes
	There were no matters arising.
3.	To receive a presentation on the Local Economic and Community Plan (LECP)
	The Members received a detailed presentation from David Jones, SEO Housing & Community, on the Local Economic and Community Plan (LECP). The Members welcomed the Plan overall and acknowledged that it would require collaboration with other bodies in order to ensure that the objectives of the Action Plan were met.
	David Jones advised that an Annual Report would be brought to the Full Council each year, which would monitor the progress of the LECP.
	He further advised that the LECP would be referred to the Regional Assembly who would meet on 5 February however he stated that it may not make this agenda due to the timeframe. The LECP would also be placed as an item on the February agenda of each Municipal District.

	The Members were advised that if the LECP was included on the Regional Assembly's agenda on 5 February, then it was anticipated that the next SPC meeting would be held at
