"To call on the Transportation SPC to consider introducing a Traffic Calming Policy referencing the National Traffic Management Guidelines and to include the following local factors:

- Requests from the majority of residents similar to the plebiscite used in planning for taking in charge requests.
- Length of road
- Recorded speed
- Accident history
- Traffic volumes
- Vulnerable road users

On adoption of the policy, each Municipal District would use these criteria to allocate funding and prioritise works."

"The preparation of the new speed by-laws has drawn attention to the need for careful consideration to be given to traffic management measures that may be required to support new speed limits, including the 30kph limits in housing estates.
