"That this Council will have a uniform roadside memorial symbol to mark areas where sudden or accidental deaths have occurred within our county."

<u>Supporting Information subject to the motion being proposed, seconded and considered.</u>

There is currently no protocol in place for roadside memorials. It is noted that the Council often receives requests to erect memorials on dangerous stretches of roads, especially at locations where there may have been a number of accidents in the past. The installation of such roadside memorials may present risks to road users, as well as to people visiting the location of a tragic accident. It is suggested that the above motion should be referred to the Transportation SPC for further consideration.
