## **ABOUT READING AGES**

The content of Barrington Stoke's books is appropriate to the actual age of the child (e.g. 8-12) or teen) but the reading age is lower. This simply means that the books are easier to read.

Their reading ages (RAs) range from 6 to 8+ and their interest ages (IAs) from 3+ to Teen.

If you don't know your child's reading age, ask them to look at the first page of the book and cover any words they can't read with a finger. If they cover more than five words per page, assume it is too difficult for them right now.
