1 To fill the casual vacancy (1 No.), following the election of former Councillor Shane Cassells to Dáil Éireann, in the Membership of Meath County Council, in accordance with Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2001, as amended.

Leas Chathaoirleach, Councillor Joe Fox opened the meeting and informed that the purpose of the Special Meeting was to fill one casual vacancy in the Membership of Meath County Council created by the election of Councillor Shane Cassells to Dáil Éireann on 27th February.

It was noted that the vacancy would be filled by co-option in accordance with the provisions of Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2001, as amended, with due notice having been given in accordance with the Act.

The co-option was then taken and Councillor Ronan McKenna proposed Padraig Fitzsimons to be co-opted to the membership of Meath County Council, seconded by Councillor Tommy Reilly.
