“That the council would address the following issues in the Gormanston area

- a) erosion of the traditional Delvin Viaduct car park and possible solutions,*
- b) the location of a lifebelt stand at Station road which is located on average at more than 1 km away from a likely emergency and the possibility of a more appropriate location,*
- c) the presence of concrete on the beach from cliff erosion. They are of no historic or archaeological value,*
- d) the roadside accumulation pile of rubbish on the Gormanston R132/M1 interchanges.”*
