2 Notice of Motion

2.1 Submitted by Sinn Féin Councillors

“That Meath County Council:

- understands that elected members have the authority to increase or reduce the local property tax rate by up to 15% each year

- recognises that there is an ever-worsening housing crisis in the county at this time

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- commits, as an act of emergency, to increase housing funding in 2016 by an amount not less than the equivalent of 15% of the local property tax collected, this being in addition to the 2015 estimated housing expenditure outturn. / Go dtuigeann Comhairle Chontae na Mí:

-go bhfuil sé i gcumhacht na mball tofa méidiú nó isliú 15% a dhéanamh ar an ráta cáin mhaoine áitiúil gach bliain
