"This question relates to unsustainable haulage distances involved in conveying waste products for processing or composting. As unsustainable haulage distances are contrary to the proximity principles regarding waste handling I would like to ask precisely which regional waste areas and waste management plans are to be involved in any future transportation of waste into County Meath from other counties? Please include details of waste management regulations pertaining to inter-regional transportation of waste following the recent National and North East Regional Waste Management reviews".
