Horse Restricted from shoreline and
Dog on leads from Sept - March**



Proposed changes to animal control at Beach

Horses permitted on All beaches as normal all year round from 5am – 11am daily

Horses restricted from traversing the dunes at Mornington and Bettystown except by way of designated 'Pathway'

Horses restricted from shoreline at River Nanny Estuary and Shore SPA from September to March – this is to protect winter feeding birds

Laytown Races will not be affected by these changes and will continue as normal.

Dogs to be kept on a lead in the River Nanny Shore and Estuary SPA from September to March – this is to protect winter feeding birds
