The development of these lands shall also provide for a civic amenity site and lands (approximately 0.5 hectares/1 acre) for the use as a depot. These lands shall be subject to the requirements of a Framework Plan (FP 3 and section 3.4.2 refers) to ensure co-coordinated and integrated development.”
