DEAR SIR/MADAM.

I AM WRITING TO YOU ABOUT THE IDEA OF BRINGING A BOARD WALK AND CYCLE LANE DOWN THROUGH TOWER ROAD. THERE ARE NO SPEED LIMITS ON THIS ROAD AND TRAFFIC TRAVEL UP & DOWN THE ROAD AT 50/60 MILES PER HOUR NOT 50/60 KLM PER HOUR. AT MY HOUSE THERE ARE A NUMBER OF CAR USERS. EACH TIME WE WANT TO USE THE ROAD WE HAVE TO EDGE OUR WAY OUT WIND DOWN THE WINDOW AND LISTEN FOR ON COMING TRAFFIC AS THERE IS A BLIND SPOT ON THIS ROAD. TO OUR LEFT WE HAVE A BUS STOP WHICH IS USED BY [REDACTED] EVERY 15 MINUTES. IN THE MORNING THERE ARE AT LEAST 6 SCHOOL BUSES ON THIS ROAD PICKING UP SCHOOL CHILDREN AND NOW WITH THE COVID 19 VIRUS EXTRA BUSES WILL BE ON THE ROAD. IN THE AFTER NOON ALL THESE BUSES

ARE BACK AGAIN. THE DISTANCE BETWEEN TOWER CROSS & MORNING GURT IS ABOUT 600 METRES. THESE BUSES WILL STOP FOUR TIMES IN THAT DISTANCE WHICH MEANS THERE IS A BUILD UP OF TRAFFIC BEHIND THE BUSES. THE DRIVERS BEHIND THE BUSES GET IMPATIENT AND POP OUT FROM BEHIND THE BUS ONTO ONCOMING TRAFFIC. THERE HAS BEEN MANY A NEAR MISS WHEN THE REFUSES LORRIES ARE IN THE AREA ALL THE BINS ARE LEFT ON THE SIDE OF THE ROAD WHICH ALSO BLOCKS YOUR VIEW. THERE ARE HUNDREDS OF HOUSES BEEN BUILT IN THE AREA. TOWER ROAD IS PART OF THE MAIN ROAD BETWEEN DROGHEDA AND LAYTOWN WHICH MEAN THE ROAD IS ONLY GOING TO GET EXTRA BUSY.

WITH THE CLOSURE OF VEHICLE ACCESS TO BETTYS TOWN BEACH ALL TRAFFIC IS HEADING FOR MORNINGTON WHERE PARKING CAN BE FOUND IN THE DUNES.

MEATH COUNTY COUNCIL ARE TRYING TO BULLY LOCAL RESIDENTS BY TAKING PART OF THEIR FRONTAGE AWAY BY KNOCKING DOWN WALLS, FENCES POLES ETC. AND THIS IS CAUSING ^{STRESS} TO LOCAL RESIDENTS. NOBODY WANTS THERE PROPERTY DESTROYED WITH MUCK & DIRT SPRAYED BY SPEEDING TRAFFIC.
