

CONSTRUCTION OF THE BOYNE GREENWAY DROGHEDA TO MORNINGTON, CO MEATH AND CO LOUTH (APB-307652-20)

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

I WISH TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING OBSERVATIONS ON THE PROPOSSED PLAN FOR THE BOYNE GREENWAY.

I FEEL THE PLANS HAVE BEEN DRAWN UP WITHOUT ANY CONSIDERATION FOR THE RESIDENTS ON TOWER ROAD /CROOK ROAD.

THE PROXIMITY OF THE GREENWAY TO MANY HOUSES AND THROUGH THE RESIDENTIAL AREA OF TOWER ROAD AND MORNINGTON COURT IS NOT IN KEEPING WITH GREENWAY POLICY.

THE ROUTE IS ALONG A BUSY ROAD AND NOT VERY SCENIC AND ENCROACHES ON THE BOYNE SAC FOR FAUNA AND FLORA AND AN SPA FOR WILDBIRDS.

I AM ALSO CONCERNED THAT THE GREENWAY WILL NOT BE SAFE FOR USE AND I WOULD BE UNWILLING TO USE IT WITH MY GRANDCHILDREN AS THERE ARE TOO MANY DRIVEWAYS EXITING DIRECTLY ONTO THE GREENWAY.

THE ROAD ALONG WHICH THE GREENWAY PASSES IS VERY BUSY WITH BUSSES AND CARS AND IT WOULD BE UNSAFE /UNPLEASANT FOR WALKERS AND CYCLISITS WITH AIR POLUTION AND IT WOULD BE MUCH BETTER IF IT WAS LOCATED ALONG THE RIVER.

THE LACK OF PARKING AND AMMENITIES ALONG THE ROUTE IS ALSO OF CONCERN .IT APPEARS THAY THE ROUTE JUST STOPS AT THE TOWER BRIDGE WITH NO PROVISION OF PARKING .DURING THE COVID LOCK DOWN PEOPLE PARKED IN DRIVEWAYS OF RESIDENTS IN ST MARYS AND ALONG THE ROAD CAUSING DISTRESS FOR THE RESIDENTS AND A SECURITY RISK .
