CONSTRUCTION OF THE BOYNE GREENWAY DROGHEDA TO MORNINGTON , CO MEATH AND CO LOUTH (APB-307652-20)

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

I WISH TO MAKE THE FOLLOWING OBSERVATIONS ON THE PROPOSED PLAN FOR THE BOYNE GREENWAY.

I FEEL THE PLANS HAVE BEEN DRAWN UP WITHOUT ANY CONSIDERATION FOR THE RESIDENTS ON TOWER ROAD /CROOK ROAD.

THE PROXIMITY OF THE GREENWAY TO MANY HOUSES AND THROUGH A RESIDENTIAL AREA IS NOT IN KEEPING WITH GREENWAY POLICY.

IT WILL BE VERY DIFFICULT FOR PEOPLE TO ENTER AND EXIT THEIR DRIVEWAYS AS THEY HAVE TO CROSS THE GREENWAY FIRST AND THIS IS A MAJOR HEALTH AND SAFETY CONCERN.

I AM ALSO CONCERNED THAT MATURE GARDENS ARE BEEN TAKEN OF RESIDENTS MEANING WALKERS WILL BE VERY CLOSE TO FRONT DOORS AND THIS IS A MAJOR LOSS OF PRIVACYPEOPLE CAN STARE IN FRONT ROOMS OF HOUSES AND RESIDENTS WILL LOOSE MATURE GARDENS THEY HAVE TENDED TO FOR MANY YEARS.

THE ROAD ALONG WHICH THE GREENWAY PASSES IS VERY BUSY WITH BUSES AND CARS AND IT WOULD BE UNSAFE /UNPLEASANT FOR WALKERS AND CYCLISTS AND IT WOULD BE MUCH BETTER IF IT WAS LOCATED ALONG THE RIVER.

THE LACK OF PARKING AND AMMENITIES ALONG THE ROUTE IS ALSO OF CONCERN .IT APPEARS THAY THE ROUTE JUST STOPS AT THE TOWER BRIDGE WITH NO PROVISION OF PARKING .DURING THE COVID LOCK DOWN PEOPLE PARKED IN DRIVEWAYS OF RESIDENTS IN ST MARYS AND ALONG THE ROAD CAUSING DISTRESS FOR THE RESIDENTS AND A SECURITY RISK .
