My husband and I are against the building of the Boyne Greenway between Drogheda and Muckinlton. These are some of the reasons we oppose:

- the Boyne Estuary is a bird sanctuary and [REDACTED] we can see the coming-and-goings of birds, all year long. Without a doubt that coming-and-going of birds will be disturbed, despite the precautions put in the proposal.
- Visually the Boyne Estuary won't look the same anymore; its natural beauty will be disturbed.
- We are also convinced the the boardwalk will attract people for the sole purpose of drug/alcohol abuse - drug dealing like on the boardwalk on the Liffey in Dublin.
