"I submitted a motion on Age Friendly Parking in Navan in March 2019 and was informed that a review process of the county was underway and that Navan would be considered for the provision of such spaces as part of that process. Can the Executive provide update on that review please?"

"Can Meath County Council confirm if a bond is in place to facilitate the clean up of the site at Academy Square, Navan to include the removal of the scaffolding and hoarding at the entrance?"

"Has there been a report carried out by Meath County Council pertaining to the structural condition of the stone walls at Old Athlumney graveyard / Ardmulchan graveyard and if so have applications been submitted for heritage grants?"

#### 7.1 Submitted by Councillor Edward Fennessy



"That Navan Municipal District Council, as part of the regeneration of Flowerhill, using finance available from that project, agrees to fund the provision of window boxes and hanging baskets to hold flowers, to be made available to any business premises or house on Flowerhill who wishes to participate in the initiative. The intention of which is to make the area colourful and friendly for the local community and visitors to the area."

#### 7.2 Submitted by Councillor Edward Fennessy

"In the interest of ensuring the safety of patrons using the Blackwater Park in Navan, this council undertakes to install a public access Automated External Defibrillator (AED) on the external wall of the changing rooms planned for construction on the park this year. The AED located on Trimgate Street to be used as an example."

"I propose the motion to discuss the possibility of placing further speed control measures in Woodlands Estate."

#### 7.4 Submitted by Councillor Francis Deane

"In cases where overgrown trees are causing damage/obstruction I propose that Meath County Council would engage with property owners whose houses are located adjacent to boundary walls between different housing developments under the charge of the local authority. Were the trees to fall they could cause structural damage to property and also there are health and safety considerations. Examples of such unoccupied areas where ownership is disputed are to be seen in Athlumney Abbey and Johnstown Wood where they are described by residents as 'no man's land'."

#### 7.5 Submitted by Councillor Francis Deane

"I call on Navan Municipal District, Meath County Council to give consideration to relocating the pedestrian crossing in Old Johnstown Village to a safer position such as adjacent to the village veterinary practice. Meath County Council have plans to resurface roads in the Old Village following the very successful installation of traffic calming ramps, and perhaps a pedestrian crossing could be placed in a better position while the proposed resurfacing works are being completed."

"I propose the motion to initiate an appraisal of the number of disability car parking spaces in the town centre. In particular, to focus on

- i) where they are situated and is it the best location for that particular street or area.
- ii) are there enough in that location.
- iii) where do we need to place new or more spaces.
- iv) are spaces very visible and is there adequate signage at their location."
