1 Election of An Cathaoirleach

The Cathaoirleach opened the meeting and reflected on his year as Cathaoirleach and the work of the Council over the last 12 months. He focused on the positivity of the last number of weeks, with the re-opening of society and businesses, as the country emerges from the Covid crisis. He touched on his inaugural speech where he reflected on the last 100 years of the Council, when his grandfather was a member of Meath County Council, but asked that the elected members consider the next 100 years and to reflect on the contribution the current generation can make and the legacy that can be left for the next generations. He referenced the different challenges that local authorities now face and the changing nature of the role of councillors. His hope was that they continue to make a difference and to be a force for positive change. Finally, he thanked all the elected members for their work and co-operation during the year and to the Management Team and various officials for their support and contribution during his term in office.

There were expressions of gratitude to the out-going Cathaoirleach from Councillors Gerry O'Connor; Sarah Reilly; Tommy Reilly; Damien O'Reilly; Brian Fitzgerald; Joe Fox; Ronan Moore; Eugene Cassidy; Trevor Golden; Edward Fennessy and Aisling O'Neill. All referenced the difficult year that it had been because of the public health restrictions, with many paying tribute to how the





Cathaoirleach chaired the Special Planning Meeting and dealt with the complex issues in a fair and open manner.

The Chief Executive thanked Councillor Gilroy for his work and contribution during his time as Cathaoirleach, she highlighted his understanding of and appreciation for the role of Cathaoirleach, his courteousness in dealing with staff and his interactions with communities and groups during the year. She presented him with an e-album of images of his time in office.

Councillor Sean Drew was declared elected as Cathaoirleach of the Council and assumed the Chair.

The newly elected Cathaoirleach addressed the meeting, thanked his proposer and seconder, thanked the out-going Cathaoirleach and Councillor Jamal. He made reference to his time as a member of the Kells Town Council since 2002 and his election to the County Council in 2014. He is the first Cathaoirleach from Kells since 1992 and considered it fitting on the 1,500 year anniversary of St Colmcille.

Looking to the year ahead, the Cathaoirleach identified a number of significant projects and initiatives which he hoped to progress in the 12 months. These included the: finalisation of the County Development Plan; the extension of the Railway to Navan; supporting the stimulus to local businesses and promoting Meath as a location for investment; the need to provide affordable homes in the county and to continue to support local tourism, the provision of broadband and the installation of CCTV in communities, where required. He thanked his family, his father, his work colleagues and party colleagues for their understanding and support and encouraged the members of the Council, during this mid-term year to work together to realise the potential of county Meath.

The Chief Executive congratulated the new Cathaoirleach and expressed her commitment to work closely with him in the year ahead.
