3.	Correspondence						
	FF briefed the Committee on a number of items of correspondence which had circulated to the LCDC prior to the meeting. The correspondence items were as follows; i. Email from Outdoor Recreation Northern Ireland regarding the National Outdoor Recreation Strategy Questionnaire.						
	ii. Email from Community Finance Ireland regarding the Launch of a new £/€10m All Island Recovery Loan Fund						
	iii. Email from Ciara Shevlin Research Assistant, School of Architecture, Planning and Environmental Policy UCD regarding their research project on Local State Society Relations						
4.	To receive an update on the SICAP mid-year review						
	FF advised the committee that the SICAP subgroup met on the 22 nd June to review the SICAP Mid-Year Review and the progress of the 2021 programme to date. FF noted that the programme is progressing very well with KPI1 at 60% achieved, KPI2 at 55% and working with those disadvantaged was already at 10% (target for the year is 17%). FF confirmed that it is not expected that there will be any difficulty in achieving the targets for 2021. FF noted that there is a carryover of funding from 2020 and the 2019 audit and that it was agreed that Meath Partnership will review the budget in September and bring forward a proposal to the LCDC for this funding. FF advised that the SICAP sub-group recommended that the 2021 Mid-Year Review be approved by the LCDC.						
	LO provided a brief update on the SICAP 2021 programme progress and highlighted some of the actions and successes to date. LO also advised that as of Thursday evening (24 th June), the target for KPI1 was at 67% achieved and the target for KPI2 was at 56% achieved.

	The committee members acknowledged and commended the SICAP team on their work and achievements with the SICAP programme to date.
