5. To receive an update on the PPN

FF provided a brief update to the committee on the PPN noting that the process to develop fundamental governance systems in the Meath PPN continues. Good governance is a requirement of DRCD policy and necessary for the network to be fit for purpose for its member groups and meet the core objectives of participation and representation.

The PPN continues to act as an information and communication hub for network member groups.

Extension of SICAP Programme

FF advised the committee that the Department have confirmed that the SICAP programme will be extended by 12 months to 31st December 2023 and noted that this was included as an option in the original tender and subsequent funding agreement.

ii. Approval of redistribution of Round 2 unclaimed Covid-19 Emergency Funding

FF advised the committee that there is a balance of €4,031 from Round 2 of the Covid-19 Emergency Funding, this arose due to applicants not claiming the full amount which had been allocated to them. FF advised that it was proposed to award this funding to Ashbourne Red Cross who were not awarded funding in the original allocations. FF noted that there is a quick turn around time required as the funding must be spent and claimed by the end of August and that Ashbourne Red Cross have indicated they will be in a position to avail of the funding within the timelines.

The approval of the balance of Round 2 Covid19 Emergency Funding to Ashbourne Red Cross was proposed by ML and seconded by TO.

iii. Next meeting

FF advised that there will be no LCDC or LAG meetings held in August and that the next meeting of the LCDC and LAG is scheduled to take place at 10.30am on Friday 24th September, 2021. FF also informed the committee the meeting may be held in a blended approach with some members physically attending, FF confirmed that the members will be advised of the approach prior to the meeting.
