1 Election of An Cathaoirleach

The Cathaoirleach opened the meeting and reflected on his year as Cathaoirleach and the work of the Council over the last 12 months. He acknowledged the many political issues that had progressed during his term in office including the adoption of the Meath County Development Plan 2021 – 2027 and the inclusion of the Navan Rail in the NTA Draft Strategy for the Greater Dublin Area. He acknowledged the level of housing allocations throughout the year and the number of housing units in the pipeline. Finally, he thanked the elected members for their work and co-operation during the year and to the Management Team and various officials for their support and contribution during his term in office. He acknowledged the work ethic and professionalism of the almost 900 staff that work for Meath County Council.

There were expressions of gratitude to the out-going Cathaoirleach from Councillors Gerry O'Connor; Damien O' Reilly; Ronan Moore; Brian Fitzgerald; David Gilroy; Eddie Fennessy; Elaine McGinty; Emer Tóibín and Francis Deane. All referenced the professionalism and dignity of the Cathaoirleach with many paying tributes to how the Cathaoirleach chaired the meetings and dealt with all issues in a fair and open manner.





The Chief Executive thanked Councillor Drew for his work and contribution during his time as Cathaoirleach, she highlighted the professional and dignified manner in which he carried out his duties as Cathaoirleach, his courteousness in dealing with staff and his interactions with communities and groups during the year. She presented him with an e-album of images of his time in office.

Councillor Nick Killian was declared elected as Cathaoirleach of the Council and assumed the Chair.

The newly elected Cathaoirleach addressed the meeting, thanked his proposer and seconder and paid tribute to the out-going Cathaoirleach. He made reference to the concerns at a council meeting in 1902 and noted the similarities between then and now.

Looking to the year ahead, the Cathaoirleach identified a number of priorities. These included: housing including the provision of social and affordable homes; homelessness; dereliction within the towns; meeting the many community groups within the county; engaging with TY programmes to help young people to understand the role of the council and councillors and the proposed closure of the Emergency Dept. at Our Lady's Hospital, Navan. He thanked his family for their understanding and support. Finally, he thanked the staff of the Solstice Theatre for their hospitality during the past year and he looked forward to the council meetings taking place in Buvinda House later in the year.

The Chief Executive congratulated the new Cathaoirleach and expressed her commitment to work closely with him in the year ahead.
