

To whom it may concern,

In September 2020 I submitted my observations in relation to the above mentioned.

I am a Resident of Mornington/East Meath and would make the following Observations and Submission

1. There is absolutely no proposal for car parking with the proposals put forward. During the recent lockdown due to Covid 19 and with such good weather, the Tower Road/Crook Road area were severely impacted with huge amounts of traffic and parking along roadsides, making it almost impossible for local residents to enter/exit their homes. If there is a greenway, there will be similar situations almost daily. Parking must be a priority.

2. Some of the residents along the proposed route stand to lose some of their gardens. These are people who have been living in the area for many years and they have no choice in the matter. This will reduce the value of their homes and bring antisocial behavior, littering and security are safety will be an issue for these residents.	
3. We feel that the Boyne Estuary will be severely impacted if this greenway goes ahead. The proposed route runs right through the Estuary which is home to many bird species who return every year. This is a protected area under European Law and must continue to be protected.	
We feel that the proposals put forward for the Boyne Greenway will have a negative impact on Mornington and surrounding area. Therefore we are not in favour of the Boyne Greenway.
