The minutes were noted.


#### 8 Correspondence

- 9.2 Councillor Ronan Moore raised the following issue:
  - 9.2.1 Raised concerns at the reduced access to GP services, resulting in new patients being unable to register with a practice and existing patients being unable to secure an appointment within a reasonable period and the knock-on effects on





both health and Accident & Emergency/Doctor-on-Call. It was agreed that a letter outlining these concerns would issue to the Minister for Health and HSE.

- 9.3 Councillor Trevor Golden raised the following issues:
  - 9.3.1 Requested that the barrier railing at the bridge on the ring road be continued on the town side.
  - 9.3.2 Queried if the Trim Masterplan has been submitted a number of meetings have taken place but nothing has been submitted as of yet.

He acknowledged the number of projects that have been progressed in Trim and other towns and villages in the municipal district during the year.
