



PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACTS 2000 – 2023

REQUEST FOR SECTION 57 DECLARATION

The above Act provides that any works which would affect the character of a protected structure, or a proposed protected structure will require planning permission, even where those works would normally be exempt under section 4(1) (h) of the Planning and Development Acts 2000 – 2023.

As an owner or occupier of a protected structure you are entitled under the above Acts to request the Council to issue a declaration as to the type of works which may or may not be permitted in the structure. In order to issue this declaration, you should supply the following information:
