

- Identifies and addresses dereliction and vacant properties
- · Identifies properties with potential for targeted redevelopment
- Identifies potential deliverables from emerging opportunities
- Develops an implementation **action plan** for its delivery
- The Plan must be guided by; detailed background information, research and analysis, a strong empirical base and developed collaboratively, engage with all stakeholders in this collaborative exercise



Large percentage of town centre space dedicated to parking













- As part of Town Centre First Scheme to develop coherent pedestrian / cycling linkages between estates , parks and facilities.




