

## Stop 1

# Newgrange UNESCO World Heritage Site



The first stop on the tour is a visit to Newgrange Stone Age Passage Tomb, the jewel in the crown of Ireland's Ancient East. Newgrange was constructed about 5,200 years ago and is part of a complex of monuments built along a bend of the River Boyne known collectively as Brú na Bóinne.

## Stop 2

#### **Emerald Park**



The 32 Roses will then head on a thrilling adventure in Ireland's only theme park and zoo, Emerald Park. With eye-popping rides, a jaw-dropping zoo and show-stopping events, the Roses will make memories that they will treasure forever.
