"I propose that Meath County Council will erect park benches to accommodate rest periods for walkers, and also to plant wildflower seeds along the greenway from Ratholdron Road to Kilberry."

"I call on Meath County Council to put in place a pilot scheme, in early spring, whereby bird boxes will be erected, at Buvinda House and at the town Hall Navan, to accommodate Swifts, an endangered bird species. Both areas, being close in proximity to the rivers Blackwater and Boyne, could be instrumental in halting their declining population. I propose the Heritage office take this project in their charge."

"I call on Navan Municipal District to repurpose the council yard on Abbey Road and transform it into a heritage pocket park, in order to fully utilize the refurbished town wall of Navan so that our local community and visitors can access our own national monument in an accessible and safe area."
