	The meeting commenced at 10.35 a.m. and SB welcomed all in attendance.

2.	Matters arising					
	FF advised that there were no matters arising.					
3.	Correspondence					
	FF confirmed that two item of correspondence, the SICAP Case Study 2023 and the Meath Wellness Hub Case Study 2023, were circulated in advance of the meeting and encouraged all the Committee to read the case studies and watch the videos as they show the exceptional work being carried out by both the SICAP and Meath Wellness Hub teams.

4.	To receive update on the status of the LECP following the October Full Council meeting					
	FF advised that the LECP was adopted by Meath County Council members at their October meeting and noted that dates of approval by the SPC and LCDC of the final framework and implementation plan have also been inserted into the plan. She stated that a number of copies of the plan will now be printed and it is hoped that the plan will be officially launched before year end and implementation of the plan will then begin in the New Year.					
5.	To receive an update on the Public Participation Network (PPN)					
	FF gave an update on the PPN as follows and noted that this update had been circulated to the Committee prior to the meeting:					
	Meath PPN held another Leadership training workshop in Summerhill Community Centre (Oct 17 th) where 14 more volunteers attended. Feedback from all trainings has been positive and the PPN is looking at facilitating further training sessions for groups across 2024.					
	A meeting of Trim MD registered groups took place on Wednesday October 18 th in Summerhill Community Centre. 30 groups were represented and took part in workshops on participation and getting involved with their local PPN. As well as presentations from Trim SEC, Teagasc, Climate Action and Enfield Credit Union, around the theme of sustainability. The evening finished with networking and a focus on the development of Linkage Groups across the network.

6.	AOB
	597 groups are now registered with Meath PPN.
	6 representatives, including Staff and Secretariat, attended the National Conference hosted by Wicklow PPN in Arklow on October 4 th - 6th. Attendees took part in discussions on the Implementation Roadmap and SPC protocols as well as excursions and workshops by community groups from Wicklow PPN. The event was addressed by Minister Joe O'Brien who emphasised the important work of PPNs across the country and announced budget supports from the Department to both PPNs and LCDCs
	Staff attended the Mindful Connect programme launch in Drogheda where the programme will be promoted through the PPN networks of Meath and Louth.
	The next Plenary will take place on Thursday November 30 th where a range of policies and procedures have been developed and agreed by Secretariat to go forward for ratification.
