

PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACTS 2000 – 2023

REQUEST FOR SECTION 57 DECLARATION

The above Act provides that any works which would affect the character of a protected structure, or a proposed protected structure will require planning permission, even where those works would normally be exempt under section 4(1) (h) of the Planning and Development Acts 2000 - 2023.

As an owner or occupier of a protected structure you are entitled under the above Acts to request the Council to issue a declaration as to the type of works which may or may not be permitted in the structure. In order to issue this declaration, you should supply the following information:

Application shall be accompanied by 1 copy of Site Location Map to the scale of 1:1,000 clearly identifying the structure and boundaries to which the application refers (subject structure to be outlined in red, overall land holding to be outlined in blue).
You will be contacted to arrange a suitable appointment for a qualified person to carry out a detailed survey of the internal and external features of the structure.
