5.1.1 To receive a Progress Report on works undertaken/planned for Laytown/Bettystown Municipal District

The report circulated in advance was noted and the members raised the following:

- Enquired if a date can be agreed to commence works on the playgrounds once the contractor has been approved. Engineer advised a date can be agreed.
- Referred to the street sweeping carried out in the South Drogheda area and if this can be included in the monthly progress report. – noted by the engineer.
- Referred to the bins on Station Road, Duleek which were overflowing engineer advised that bins checked daily and will follow up.
- Enquired if the two Colpe road roundabouts and top of Mill Road be included in the grass cutting contract along with Beamore cross and Platin junction- noted by the engineer.
- Sought a completion date for the Donacarney cycle way works- engineer to revert with a date.

	The members raised the following:
Cllr	Elaine McGinty:

- Referred to no footpath/ cycleway on the Beamore Road causing a danger to people using the road referred to engineer.

• Referred to flooding on the Beamore road with heavy rainfall- referred to engineer.

- A need for footpaths on the Platin road Duleek where pedestrians are walking referred to engineer.
- Referred to a yellow box needed at Avourwen estate to Wolfe Tones club house, Drogheda referred to engineer.
- Enquired when road lining will be completed at Bryanstown Wood, Beamore Road advised that the developer will be completing these works.
- Referred to the green kilometre and intends organising this event again with environment.





Cllr Sharon Tolan:

- Referred to the members rep's portal where a case updates as being resolved but works remain outstanding to follow up on the details.
- Referred to a footpath that needs to be repaired in the Cloisters, Bettystown- noted by engineer.
- The barrier is damaged at Southgate roundabout and grass need to be trimmed- noted by the engineer.
- The gate into the Bettystown playground needs repairing. engineer to follow up.
- Enquired if there was any update on the OPW flooding report- to follow up with environment.
- Referred to black bags dumped in the Old Mill, Julianstown –submitted to members reps.
- The Wildflowers along Tara Road, Bettystown need to be cut so they will grow back. engineer to follow up.
- Enquired when the lighting will be repaired to the Voyager and at the Triton Roundaboutengineer to follow up.
- Referred to dips on the Narroways Road at the Maples, Bettystown where a road opening was carried out by a contractor – Engineer to follow up.
- Enquired on an update to the footpath to connect the boardwalk from the Golf links road-Engineer to follow up.

Cllr Wayne Harding:

- Raised concerns that the road where the NS school in Duleek needs to be gritted and referred to all roads to schools need to be included – Fiona Lawless suggested that this be raised at the Transport SPC to look at the feasibility of schools close to regional roads to be included on gritting routes.
- Referred to speeding along the Donore to Staleen road- noted by engineer.
- Enquired if a sign for horses crossing be erected on the Tubberfin road at Franks Cottagenoted by engineer.,
- Referred to break in footpath to the Drogheda retail park, coming from Donore.
- Referred to a second public light required at the houses in Beauparc, Slane.
- Raised concerns around the parking at the pub in Laytown-noted by engineer.

Cllr Geraldine Keogan:

- Referred to businesses affected by Uisce Eireann and ESB outages.
- Enquired if a one-way system be installed at the Spire to the Navan Road, Duleek engineer to review.



- Sought update on when works are commencing on lower Duleek/Station Road junction-referred to engineer for an update.
- Enquired on road safety measures for Carranstown road.

Cllr Paddy Meade:

- Referred to the locals gritting the roads in Lobinstown village as they were blocked due to black ice
- Enquired when the banks will be lowered near the playground to allow for a stand in areanoted by the engineer.
- Referred to speeding in Donore village and noted by engineer.
- Raised the parking issue in Laytown village which was noted by engineer.
- Referred to the ongoing issues with broadband in Lobinstown Fiona Lawless advised will seek a report from the Council's Broadband officer on the broadband coverage in that area.
