5.1.1 To receive a Progress Report on works undertaken/planned for Trim Municipal District.

The report circulated in advance and was noted. Interventions included:

- On the approach to Enfield roundabout can the existing line markings be realigned or better signage installed.
- Overgrown vegetation at Scarriff bridge, Ballinabrackey and Castlejordan junction is causing car mirrors to be clipped. Can this be cut back?
- Recent road safety improvements at Baconstown National School have been much improved. However, it is felt that a pedestrian crossing is still needed between the two schools on the same road.
- Can Members have access to a platform where they can track existing and previous reps, and reps made by other members in hope that they avoid duplicating reps that other Members may have submitted.
- Can a letter issue to An Garda Siochana asking that the Speed Camera Van be deployed once again on the Summerhill Road opposite Trim Celtic FC as this proved successful when last deployed.
