Stream B will provide funding for the **protection and conservation of sites** including essential repairs and works such as structural stability, weather tightness, resilience to climate change, protection against erosion or damage by livestock, young saplings or invasive problematic plants and other repairs. Funding for conservation advice or for the preparation of a Conservation Management Plan and detailed specifications of works or an Archaeological Impact Assessments are also eligible.
