Notice is hereby given under the Control of Horses Act 1996 the horses described below:



Were detained pursuant to Section 37 of the Control of Horses Act, 1996. Within a period of five days from the date of detention of the said horse, the horse may be released to the owner or keeper of the horse, on proof being tendered of his ownership or right to keep the horse, on production of an appropriate current horse licence, horse passport and on payment of all outstanding fees, expenses and charges in respect of the horse, provided that detention of the horse is not required by Meath County Council or a Superintendent of the Garda Síochána, in accordance with Section 39 (1) (a), (b) or (c) of the Act and provided that Meath County Council or Superintendent is satisfied that adequate accommodation and sustenance and, if necessary, adequate veterinary attention will be provided for the horse and if satisfied that the horse will not be cruelly treated. Failing this the horse may be disposed of in accordance with the Act and the Control of Horses Bye Laws 2012.
