### **Certain requirements apply to this C.I.S. scheme:**

The scheme is operated on the basis of a 10% contribution to the overall cost of the works being made by the local community. **The local contribution is monetary only – no works are to be undertaken by local communities on the public road in lieu of this monetary contribution.** This scheme is particularly aimed at cul-de-sacs and this will be taken into account when prioritising the roads which would be eligible for funding.

Following submission of a completed application:

- (a) Applicants must provide details of road length and width and the number of dwellings along the road and this information will be recorded and verified by Meath County Council.
- (b) Meath County Council will estimate the overall cost of each scheme taking account of material, labour, machinery and traffic management costs. The community contribution in each case will be 10% of the estimate.
- (c) Taking into account the findings of your completed application Meath County Council will prioritise the roads which would be eligible under the “Community Involvement Scheme”. An application for funding will be made to the Department of Transport for all the schemes applied for. Once the allocation is confirmed by the Department of Transport, successful applicants will be notified if their application has been selected for funding and asked to confirm if they wish to proceed.
